Frequently Asked Questions

1. What time is the camp each week?

Camps run from 9am to 4pm. Before and after care is available for an additional fee.

2. How much is the extended care fee?

Extended care starts at 8 am and can be extended to 5pm. The cost is \$25+HST/student/week.

3. Can I register more than one child?

Yes! There is a 10% discount for each child.

4. What is the recommended age range for campers?

The camps are recommended for boys and girls aged 5-9.

5. Do they have to wear specific shoes?

Please provide students with both indoor and outdoor footwear. Indoor shoes should be non-marking. Outdoor shoes should allow for outside play. Please, for safety reasons, no sandals.

6. What do I pack for the week?

You will be given a camper's list. This often includes, a change of clothes (including underwear and socks), bathing suit, sunblock, hat, indoor and outdoor shoes, healthy options for snacks and lunch.

7. How do I register?

8. Is there is a performance at the end for the parents?

Yes! Each week there is a dance performance at 3:50pm for parents to showcase the work they did during the week!

9. Is there a uniform?

Students will receive a camper's t-shirt. There are specific theme days during which students are asked to dress up. This information will be in your camper's package.

10. Do I need to bring a lunch on Friday?

Nope! Every Friday, all campers get a pizza lunch!

11. What if my child has an allergy?

Please alert the front desk to any allergies at registration.

12. When does registration open?

Registration is open NOW! Call us, email us or visit us on the web!

13. What COVID-19 protocols are in place?

Class sizes are limited to 8 campers/room. Students must wear masks and sanitize frequently throughout the day. Staff and students are screened daily. Students are distanced as often as possible.

14. What if the regulations change again?

We will be following all Ontario regulations for summer camps. If requirements change and the camp cannot run a full refund will be issued, or a credit for another camp/program at THE ACADEMY, if requested.

15. What is the weekly cost for the camp?

Each camp is \$150 + HST.
